To: All Citizens of Ojibway Nation of Saugeen: Re Dissident Meeting on June 21, 2019

This letter is further to the letter we delivered to all community members on January 30, 2019. A group of six dissidents in our community have continued to take illegal actions that are harming our community. On June 21, 2019, these dissidents held a fake "Traditional Gathering" at which they attempted to "elect" themselves as the Chief and Headmen of Ojibway Nation of Saugeen. These Dissidents are John Machimity; Darlene Necan; Joyce Medicine; Ron Machimity Sr.; Hilda DeRose; Betty Necan.


We want all Citizens to know that these Dissidents have no legal authority to remove the duly appointed Chief and Headmen and "elect" themselves as a new government of Ojibway Nation of Saugeen. We are taking all appropriate steps to deal with the Dissidents and their unlawful actions.


As you are aware, we provided formal notice to all our Citizens about a Traditional Gathering that included a review, which was held on June 20, 2019 at the new Community Centre. The Traditional Gathering was facilitated by Roger Bouvier, and recorded. The Traditional Gathering was officially closed on June 20, 2019, as all comments from members were received and the Chief presented his succession plan formally to our members. **We are taking all appropriate steps to deal with the Dissidents and their unlawful actions.**

The unlawful actions against the Chief and Headmen, by the Dissidents, must stop. Such actions are completely contrary to the social and economic wellness of our community. Such actions are disrespectful, and are tearing families apart. How we all conduct ourselves affects our children, and they deserve better. We want all Citizens to know that we are working hard to represent all current and future members' interests, and are always willing to meet to respectfully discuss all matters of concern to our Citizens. We listened carefully to the comments of **all** our members given to us before, at, and after our Traditional Gathering on June 20, 2019, and will continue to make decisions in our children's' best interests.
