



DECEMBER 10, 2021 COMMUNITY NOTICE

The Ojibway Nation of Saugeen now has a total of 3 positive cases in the community. The nurses will return to the community in about 7 days to retest. As soon as a date is confirmed, we will post.

For the safety of the community and surrounding communities, ONS will have security at the Main Access to monitor all incoming and outgoing travel for the purpose of contact tracing. Effective December 13, 2021.

All ONS community residents need to self-monitor for symptoms and immediately self-isolate if they feel unwell. Be advised that symptoms may not be present for at least 5 days after contact. If you have symptoms, please seek medical attention and/or get tested for COVID-19.

We strongly recommend that all community members stay home and isolate regardless if they have been tested and received a negative test result.

The Saugeen Health Centre is CLOSED to the public.
