

Community Health Representative (CHR)- (Fixed Term 6 months)
The Ojibway Nation of Saugeen (ONS)

JOB OVERVIEW: The CHR will be under the direction and supervision of the Band Manager and will provide health care support services to community members in coordination with Healthcare Professionals to achieve community healthcare objectives.

Wage: \$18.00 per hour; **Minimum** 35-hour work week

MAIN JOB TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with the delivery of health care services within the community of the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen, by directing community members to appropriate services, scheduling services, and following up with service delivery.
- To be available within the community to provide any medical assistance and on call emergency services and to schedule such accordingly with other frontline staff on an alternate basis during weekdays/weekends.
- To be available to take appropriate action in referring them to other frontline workers or outside agencies.
- Assist with the community health nurse's clinics as far as taking patients to the examining room, take blood pressures, vitals, temperatures, and weight.
- Maintain program data collection and reporting requirements, including taking water samples and other regulatory requirements and home inspections for air quality.
- Prepare annual work plans.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND SKILLS:

- Certificate, Diploma or Degree in Health Field studies preferred, or equivalent work experience in a related field.
- Written & verbal skills in English, with a preference for knowledge of the Ojibway language (verbal).
- Experience working in a small community setting, with a preference for working in a First Nations community.
- Ability to work independently and within a team.
- First Aid, CPR certification an asset or willing to obtain.
- Current and satisfactory Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Search, as well as current and satisfactory Child Abuse Registry Check.
- First consideration will be given to applicants who are members of the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen.
- A valid driver's license is an asset
