OJIBWAY NATION OF SAUGEEN SECURITY NOTICE

The Ojibway Nation of Saugeen have obtained the professional services of the Northwest Security Services Inc, to manage the Checkpoint at the main access into the community.

The security will be in place to monitor the Health and Safety of the community for 24 hours, 7 days a week, effective April 19, 2021 at 6:00 a.m. to July 19, 2021.

We would like to remind all that the province is in a Stay-at-home order.

We ask all community residents to continue to be diligent in self-monitoring for symptoms, and immediately self-isolate if you feel unwell. Be advised that symptoms may not be present for at least 5 days after contact. If you have symptoms, please seek medical attention and/or get tested for COVID-19. Please continue to follow the COVID-19 Protocols. Stay Home, Maintain Social Distancing. Wash/Sanitize hands, and wear masks.
