



JANUARY 5, 2022 UPDATE COMMUNITY NOTICE

Chief and Headmen would like to inform ONS community residents that all COVID-19 cases in the community were resolved as of December 25, 2021. We want the community to remain vigilant with COVID-19 and the variants in the area.

Ontario Premier Doug Ford announced January 3rd, 2020 that;

Ontario is moving schools online for at least two weeks, temporarily closing indoor dining and gyms and pausing non-urgent medical procedures.

The province announced all publicly funded and private schools will move to remote learning starting January 5th until at least January 17th.

The Ojibway Nation of Saugeen will NOT be locking down but will continue to monitor the Main access to the community. Each community member will do their part to be safe and keep the community safe.

ONS employees will work from home; the school is closed to in-person learning, and the Health Centre staff will be available to clients.

Contractors/ Service Providers:

Contractors or service providers who enter the community to perform work will be required to get a rapid test at the Health Centre; results take approximately 20 minutes. The work duties can commence with a negative test result.

We recommend essential travel only at this time.
