New hours:

Main access open: 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

We will continue with the following:

1. Road closed from 12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. (Excluding Police and Ambulance)
2. ONS residents ONLY
3. Essential travel ONLY
 - a. Medical appointments
 - b. Grocery shopping
4. Essential Services
 - a. Police/Ambulance
 - b. Plumbers/Electricians
 - c. Internet/Satellite
 - d. Hydro One
 - e. Bell Canada
 - f. Health Services – doctors, nurses, SLFNHA, NWHU.
5. Document EVERY vehicle entering or exiting the community.
6. Any person who disagrees can forward a letter to Chief and Headmen.
7. Continue with shared custody/visitations.

We would like to remind all that the province is in a Stay-at-home order is in effect until June 2, 2021.

Continue with all safety precautions such as hand sanitizing, wearing masks, social distancing, stay at home if feeling not feeling well. If you have symptoms, please seek medical attention and/or get tested for COVID-19.
