**POSITION OVERVIEW:**

At the direction of the Customary Chief and Headmen, the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen protects, preserves and enhances Treaty and Aboriginal rights for the benefit and protection of its citizens and membership. With the above mandate in mind, the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen is looking for skilled communicators with a demonstrated experience of building effective working relationships with Aboriginal Communities.

The primary responsibility of the Community Engagement Liaison will be to engage with the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO) on a proposed Deep Geological Repository (DGR) and Adaptive Phase Management (APM) for nuclear waste (the "Project") in the Treaty #3 Territory.

**POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Working for the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen, the successful candidate will:

- Facilitate and manage the implementation of an agreement between the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen and NWMO by developing an engagement framework and decision-making process, establishing working relationships with the Treaty communities, organizing information sharing sessions, and providing program specific professional advice;
- Facilitate and/or participate in engagement activities to provide regular project updates in cooperation with NWMO representatives, to inform the community of proposed decisions related to the Project, and to request information about interests and/or concerns related to the Project;
- Respond to issues relating to the communities social, health, cultural, and/or lands and resource management interests by preparing technical reports and providing recommendations;
- Prepare briefing notes, presentations, and technical reports on complex issues related to the Project and develop options to assist the Customary Chief and Headmen, and Band Manager with decision-making;
- To review and evaluate information and make recommendations;

- Act as a liaison and point of contact on behalf of the Customary Chief and Headmen for Project- related enquiries;
- Serve as a liaison between the Customary Chief and Headmen and NWMO engagement lead and/or other NWMO representatives as required;
- Maintain an accurate database of the Ojibway Nation of Saugeen's engagement activities;
- Other duties as assigned.
